"The Purpose Driven Life" is one of the more popular Christian books in recent years, but it is not without controversy. The author, Rick Warren, is pastor of a Southern Baptist mega-church in Orange County which boasts more than 15,000 members. The spiritual premise of the book is that God has a purpose for everyone, and by following a few simple steps, we can all uncover the purpose intended for us. The book consists of 40 short chapters, and is intended to be read over a 40 day period. The book draws heavily on the Bible, but some critics have commented that it lacks depth because it is divided into so many short chapters.

"It is Well With My Soul"

On November 22, 1873 one of the most luxurious ships of the time sank. Two hundred and twenty-six lives were lost, including the only children of Mr. And Mrs. H.G. Spafford of Chicago. Mrs. Spafford was taking the four children to Europe for a vacation and Mr. Spafford was to join them in a few weeks.

As soon as he could, Mr. Spafford booked a passage to Europe to join his grieving wife. On the way over the ship's Captain informed Mr. Spafford that they were now at the approximate place where his children had been lost. That night he found it difficult to sleep, and out of his heart break and pain he wrote the words to the hymn "It is Well With My Soul", the first stanza of which contains these lines:

When peace like a river attendeth my way, When sorrows like sea-billow roll, Whatever my lot, Thou hast taught me to say, It is well, it is well with my soul.

Sometimes it is in our deepest pain that we find God. It is certainly in our darkest moments that we learn that we must trust God fully. These are hard lessons to learn, and most of us have to learn them over and over again. But in our learning, we eventually come to that same moment as did Mr. Spafford, when we too can say, "It is well with my soul."




