Joy to the World

Around Christmas and Easter time there is a thought that is shared in churches and by other people of faith, "If it weren't for the Resurrection there would be no Christmas." That is definitely true. I would like to share more on this thought. If



Jesus wasn't raised from the dead and did not appear to the disciples afterward, the story of Jesus would probably be a chapter in a history book.
