Christ Climbed Down

As we begin the Advent Season, head to the celebration of Christmas and the coming of God into the world through Jesus the Christ, I began reflecting on the carol *Love Came Down at Christmas*. It's a beautiful carol and fun to sing. But it doesn't give you the reality that Jesus was born into the struggles of God's people. This song gives us the joy of the season, but not the reason we are worshiping and following Christ.

This got me thinking of another writing, a poem by Lawrence Ferlinghetti written in 1962, *Christ Climbed Down.* I share this poem with you as you prepare your hearts and souls for Christ being reborn within you this Christmas. Do not be swept away by all the hoopla and trappings of a secular Christmas. But pay attention to the reality and simplicity of the sacrifice by which God's love came to us in the birth of God's son. Though some of the images and language may be dated, the thoughts and points made are very much relevant today. I offer this poem to you for devotion and thought this Christmas Season.

Christ climbed down from His bare Tree this year and ran away to where there were no rootless Christmas trees hung with candy canes and breakable stars Christ climbed down from His bare Tree this year and ran away to where there were no gilded Christmas trees and no tinsel Christmas trees and no tinfoil Christmas trees and no pink plastic Christmas trees and no gold Christmas trees and no black Christmas trees and no powder blue Christmas trees hung with electric candles and encircled by tin electric trains and clever cornball relatives Christ climbed down from His bare Tree this year and ran away to where no intrepid Bible salesmen covered the territory in two-tone Cadillacs


