Rick's Ramblings

A New Year, A New Hope

Over this Christmas season I received a Christmas Card and a special note that I want to pass on to you. I pray that it will lift you up as we move into the new year, inspire you, and keep the vision of living out the love and hope of Jesus Christ before you.

I received many Christmas Cards including from you my Church Family that brought joy into my heart. The one particular card came after the first of the year from Girl Scout Troop 1954. This Troop of young girls began their journey two years ago as a new troop and sought a place to meet. The Troop leader and her daughter were a part of PALS (preschool) a few years ago and they felt welcomed by our congregation. So, we were asked if this was where they could meet to start as a new troop. We embraced and welcomed them. In appreciation of how we have welcomed them, they shared Christmas cards with both Mary and me. Their kindness really touched me. The message of the card spoke to me as I feel the love of Christ moving into the new year:

Praying the Love of God will fill you with joy, the peace of God will fill you with hope, and the grace of God will surround you with the reminders of His presence this Christmas and in the new year.

Another message was shared from a colleague who leads her own church consultation and support ministry, Mary Scifres Ministries. I found these words inspirations and uplifting as I look to 2020.

As we move on from the beauty of the Christmas season, I am reminded of a lesson I learned in seminary. A doctoral candidate in Religion and Literature argued that the Christian tradition was essentially false because stories of virgin births, angels appearing to shepherds,

and wise men following a star never actually happened—they were simply fanciful way of saying: This baby's birth is important to us.

Our professor responded wryly: "I see. So the tradition that inspired Michelangelo's statue of David and his work in the Sistine chapel, the tradition that produced thousands of years of hymns and music glorifying God, the tradition that produces so much beauty around Christmas time, that tradition is false. No tradition that inspires such beauty is false."

Every year at this time, I feel in my soul how true that statement is. Our challenge is to keep the beauty of Christmas alive in our hearts throughout the year. Remember the feelings of caroling to shut-ins, recall the joy of Christmas pageants and Christmas teas. The challenge of the new year is to live the truth of Christmas in the present-day of our ordinary lives.

As you live through this year 2020, I pray that you will find these words as touching and strengthening as I did.

May God Guide us as the Star guided the Magi, May God protect us as God protected the Holy Family as we strive to be the love of Christ in all that we do each day this year.

BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Black History Month is an annual observance originating in the United States, where it is also known as African-American History Month.

The Father of Black History Month, Dr. Carter G. Woodson, was born in 1875, near New Canton, VA. He was the son of former slaves. In 1907, he obtained his BA degree from the University of Chicago. In 1912, he received his PhD from Harvard University.

In 1915, he and friends established the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History. A year later, the *Journal of Negro History*, began quarterly publication. In 1926, Woodson proposed and launched the annual February observance of "Negro History Week," which became "Black History Month" in 1976. It is said that he chose February for the observance because February 12th was Abraham Lincoln's birthday and February 14th was the accepted birthday of Frederick Douglass.
