Thanks to all of the new scrip purchasers this month! We've had higher sales lately since Karen Benvenuto reminded us all to use scrip for the weekly purchases we all make anyway. Please consider using our scrip for one or two purchases a month to help our church. Thank you Karen for your words of encouragement!

On the First Sunday of each month, you may purchase scrip with your credit card, but not all scrip can be purchased by credit since we are charged a small fee for each purchase. With that in mind, we can only offer the scrip that TUMC earns at 7% or higher. A list of the available scrip for purchase by credit card is posted on the Scrip Bulletin board in the breezeway, or pick up a list at the scrip table.

We are offering this method of payment to encourage you to participate in our scrip fundraiser. Our goal is to raise as much as possible for our general church budget; usually about \$5,000-\$6,000 per year, but our spring sales have been lower than normal. Also, Pastor Randy can help you with your credit purchase Monday through Thursday at the church office. Please call first to let him know you want to purchase scrip.
