CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Filipino Members Organize Sunday 9:00 a.m. Bible Study Class in the Tagalog Language

Recognizing the changing demographic character of our city, TUMC has authorized the establishment of a Bible Study Class on Sundays from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. (Room 1) in the Tagalog language. Under the mentorship and guidance of Rev. David Brostrom, TUMC's Pastoral Consultant, Filipino members of the congregation decided to take this step as an outreach tool to other members of the community.

The first session began on Sunday, November 4th at 9 a.m., enabling members to attend Worship Service at 10:30 a.m. Dan Gutierrez and Vinya Gulla provided the leadership in getting the curriculum and the teaching facilitators.

The materials used are purchased from official UMC outlets and are approved by the General Board of Discipleship of the United Methodist Church. Rev. David Brostrom outlined twelve suggestions which the group adopted and followed. They confirmed the teaching facilitators on a rotating basis. In the beginning, Dan Gutierrez and Vinya Gulla will be teaching the class.

The mission and purpose of the class is to "grow in the Christian faith and watch over one another in love by studying and living the ancient words from the Holy Bible" as suggested by the teachings of Brother Serge Peña and patterned after John Wesley's theological concepts.

The members of the class chose the name "Philippians" because it is the name close to our birth country's name, "the Philippines", and it is in the Bible.



We feel that this class can serve as an example of what other linguistic groups can do to reach out to their respective communities. In time, we plan to hold potlucks and invite members of our congregation as well as people from the Filipino-American community, so that we can all learn about our culture and language and people can become aware of the friendly place that TUMC is and how it welcomes all people.

Dan Gutierrez recently reported to the Christian Education Committee on the class and outlined its teaching objectives. He was asked to become a member of the Committee and regularly give a report on its activities. Gloria Galvez will monitor attendance and make a monthly report to Pastor Randy Johnson on all activities.



As we go into the holiday season we can be grateful for the many blessings that we have received this year. I thank the Church Council for their support this year and the dedication they and their respective work areas have given for the congregation.

We started the year brain storming for goals and visions. Some of these goals have come to fruition; others will continue to be worked on in 2008.

Trustees have maintained our facilities to ensure safety and adequate space for our congregation as well as the many outside groups.

The Worship Committee have provided guest speakers throughout the year and initiated the Church potlucks on the 5th Sundays.

Our church is well recognized for the support we give for Mission Outreach Projects. We support three missionaries, two in Los Angeles and one in the Philippines. Our Bread from Heaven Food Pantry is serving 60 – 70 families every Monday morning for a total of approximately 260 people weekly. Volunteers spend many hours shopping and packaging food and dispensing to clients.

Two new staff members have been added this year, Rev. David Brostrom and Earl Fields. The Music Program is expanding and we have had some beautiful concerts. Rev. Brostrom is doing visitation and creating some new programs for seniors.

Several highlights throughout 2007 were the Gala, Yard Sale, Annual Craft Faire, Ministry Faire, Sierra Service Project, starting the Prayer and Meditation Garden and Memorial Courtyard and the Monks Golf Tournament.


