2010 CRAFT FAIRE GAINS MOMENTUM

Planning for the 13th Annual Craft Faire, October 23rd, is well underway. Twenty-five applications have been accepted as of June 6th. Over 60 vendors participate each year. Only high quality handicrafts are accepted. Crafts are sought in wood art, floral, jewelry, ceramics, sewing arts, paper crafts, home décor, soaps and lotions, oil and watercolor painting, holiday art and more.

Space rental fees are \$40 for limited inside space and \$35 for patio and grass areas. Proceeds are used to help fund local community outreach and TUMC programs.

The Tuesday Ladies' Bible Study will once again prepare and serve a Continental Breakfast and lunch, which will be available at a nominal cost.

UMW will host their annual Bake Sale as well as the popular sale of used books, CDs and videos. Begin looking for those items which you no longer use. 
