



## Wesley Bell Ringers



The Wesley Bell Ringers, a group of 27 high school students from Christ United Methodist Church, in Salt Lake City, Utah, will play their nearly two hundred precision tuned handbells in a concert at Temecula United Methodist Church on Tuesday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, at 7:30 p.m. The concert is part of the choir's 45<sup>th</sup> annual concert tour.

Over the past 44 years the choir has visited and played in all 50 states and in 9 Canadian Provinces. They have performed in such diverse places as Mount Rushmore National Monument, the United States Capitol, Walt Disney World and The Cathedral of the Pines National Shrine. The choir has performed several times with the

Mormon Tabernacle Choir and has appeared with the Utah Symphony. They also performed at the Salt Lake Winter Olympics in 2002.

The Wesley Bell Ringer Choir has been featured in newspapers and magazines, has played on radio and television and has produced 16 recordings. They have been honored as the demonstration choir at numerous handbell festivals. This year, the choir has been invited to perform the opening night concert for the Area XI Festival of the American Guild of English Handbell Ringers. That concert will be in Tucson on June 18<sup>th</sup>.

The program includes both sacred and secular music, and is designed to show the versatility of Handbells. The program includes works as diverse as "Little Fugue" (J.S. Bach) arranged by Michael Dastner, and "African Alleluia", composed by Cathy Moklebust incorporating African drum accompaniment. Arrangements by well known arrangers of handbell music, Arnold Sherman, Karen Lakey Buckwalter, Ed Duncan and Fred Gramann will also be performed. Verdi's "Anvil Chorus", arranged by Tracey Slinger is wonderfully adapted for handbells. The concert is an extraordinary musical experience presented by an extraordinarily dedicated group of young people.


