## WESLEY BELL RINGERS COME TO TUMC!

Tuesday, June 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. the Wesley Bell Ringers from Christ United Methodist Church, Salt Lake City, Utah, will be in concert at Temecula United Methodist Church in Celebration Hall. Director Terry Waite explains this tour is built around the American Guild of English Handbell Ringers Area XI Festival held in Tucson from the 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> of June. The Ringers are honored to have been selected as the "featured choir" and will present the opening night concert for a couple of hundred other bell ringers. The challenge this presents to them will result in an extra special musical presentation for all their audiences on this tour, including TUMC. The choir has a new website: <a href="https://www.wesleybells.com">www.wesleybells.com</a> – each page of the site provides an opportunity to hear the choir play, and there are pages showing photos and the choir history.

They will arrive at TUMC at 5 p.m. on June 15<sup>th</sup> to have a brief rehearsal and a pre-concert meal at 6:15 p.m. PROVIDED BY TUMC CONGREGATION - we will need volunteers.

The Music Department has agreed to find host families for the thirteen boys, fourteen girls and eight or nine adults traveling with the group. The Host family will provide housing the night of June 15<sup>th</sup> and breakfast the following morning before returning them to TUMC by 8 a.m.

Most of the youth may be housed in pairs and three or four adult couples plus one or two single adults, as well.

Contact Earl Fields or Deb Potts - who is helping to coordinate this event - if you can host students or a few adults. The Wesley Bell Ringers are from Deb's former church in Salt Lake City. We will also have a signup sheet in the breezeway.

To earn revenue for our church through the Ralphs Community Contribution Program you now have to register your Rewards Card each year at www.ralphs.com choosing TUMC as the organization you want to support. A second way to link your card is to pick up the Ralphs scanbar letter at the scrip table and take that with you to swipe at the register the next time you check out at the store. The scanbar letter only needs to be swiped one time.

Only 10 people are currently signed up compared with 65 households before Ralphs made changes to their program. We would like everyone who shops at Ralphs to register their card and link it to our church. Your purchases will then automatically generate revenue for TUMC. Ralphs does not offer a scrip (gift card) program, so there are no gift cards to buy. Please note: on the website you can search for our church by name or by our organization number, 80434. 


