# Bridging the Gap

Members of our Church Council, Finance and Stewardship committees have been hard at work looking at ways to be good stewards of God's gifts by addressing TUMC's financial needs.



After many hours of discussion and planning, we believe the best way to move our church forward would be to retire our smallest loan early. This is the ORIGI-NAL loan for the church property and the ORIGINAL building construction and is also the smallest loan that is being funded out of the annual budget.

Recent communications you have received have called attention to the challenges in these tough economic times that we are having funding our 2008 budget.

We believe the best way forward, that saves the most money, is to pay off the smallest loan over the next 15 months or by the end of 2009. At the end of December this year, the balance on this 7% loan will be approximately \$62,000.00, including interest. Early pay-off will save approximately \$800.00 per month or about \$9,600.00 annually in interest.

We will be introducing a detailed plan to explain this proposal on a Sunday in September. Until then, please be in prayerful consideration about how you may be able to help us BRIDGE THE GAP to the future.

## What do United Methodist Believe?

That question is the number one question of new persons to the church. I found the following "snapshot" in the latest edition of the United Methodist Worldwide News by Robin Russell.

96% are "absolutely" or "fairly certain" that God exists

42% say they attend church at least once a week; 14% say they seldom or never attend church

59% say they pray at least once a day

15% say their prayers are answered at least once a week.

28% say their prayers are seldom or never answered

25% believe the Bible should be taken "literally" 21% say it's written by men, not God 44% say it's the Word of God but probably shouldn't be taken literally

82% believe there is more than one way to interpret their religious teachings

85% believe many religions can lead to eternal life

51% believe "Homosexuality is a way of life that should be accepted by society". 39% disagree

59% believe abortion should be legal in all or most cases; 29% say it should be illegal in most cases

42% believe the U.S. should be active in world affairs; 50% we should focus more on problems at home

29% say stricter environmental laws would hurt the economy; 63% say it would be worth the cost

47% lean toward or are Republican; 42% lean toward or are Democratic

Orphanage.




