Helpful Hints on Using Gift Cards

Gift cards make great holiday gifts for family members, friends and co-workers. They are fun to give and receive since the recipient can shop for exactly what they need. Here are some helpful suggestions and information for getting the most from using gift cards:

Gift cards sold in California never expire so if a merchant tells you that there is no balance on your card (and you know there is) just ask the cashier to enter the numbers from the back of the card manually. This often works when the card doesn't scan correctly because of dirty card scanners. You can also call the 800 phone # on the back of the gift card and check the balance right on the spot with your cell phone. In all the many years I have used gift cards, I have never lost a balance on a card.

Use a Sharpie pen to write down any remaining balance left on the card or wrap the receipt with the remaining card balance around the card. Mini Sharpie pens are available to buy at the scrip table for a nominal charge.

Pre-order your scrip so that you will have what you need, especially before the holidays. Don't wait until the last minute and hope that we have what you need. Occasionally, we do sell out of some of our scrip, especially near the holidays. It's impossible to estimate which scrip will be popular, so pre-order when you can. You can see the whole list of available scrip at the Great Lakes Scrip Center website at glscrip.com.

Something new to our scrip program this year is the TUMC Gift Card that you can buy for any amount you wish and give to another member or friend at our church. The recipient brings the gift card back to the scrip table and exchanges it for any scrip that we have in our inventory.

A new law went into effect in 2008 that helps you when your gift card has a remaining balance under \$10. The new California law states that you can ask for the balance in cash. Most merchants know about this law, but many do not. You can pick up a copy of the law at the scrip table.

Please participate in this fundraiser so that TUMC can reach its goal of raising \$8,000 this year. Using scrip does not cost you any more than what you planned to spend and there is no work involved on your part. There is no limit on how much revenue we can raise with our scrip fundraiser. The only limitation is our participation level. So, let's take advantage of this great opportunity we have.
