Another video-based series from the Living the Questions folks in Phoenix will be offered to TUMC members and friends. The continuing series gives insights, perspectives, and content that often has only been available at the Theological Seminary level.

Why were the titles of Caesar Augustus – Divine, Son of God, God from God, Lord, Redeemer, Liberator, and Savior of the World – taken from a Roman emperor on the Palatine Hill and given to a Jewish peasant on the Palestine plain? Was it low lampoon or high treason? Either way, the Romans were not laughing.

What were the priorities of Jesus' proclamation of the Kingdom? How was the status quo of Roman imperial theology subverted by this obscure Galilean whose message continues to indict empire today?

First Light is a 12-session DVD and web-based study of the historical Jesus and the Kingdom of God with two of the world's leading Jesus scholars on location throughout the Galilee and Jerusalem.

A study resource will be used specializing on grief and loss, and unhurried time for sharing will be featured at each workshop. Vanessa is the daughter of Gayle and Bud Skennion who grew up in this church and recently graduated from Long Beach State with a degree in Human Development. She is currently enrolled in a Master's degree program in Marriage and Family Counseling. As part of her under-graduate program, Vanessa took advantage of grief support groups and made the area of grief and loss recovery a special interest of hers. 




