Taught by Bill Steele

Beginning in September, a course in Methodism will be offered for everyone in the Congregation. The book entitled, John Wesley, *Holiness of Heart & Life*, by Charles Yrigoyen, Jr. will be used as the guide to lead the discussion on Methodism. This book examines "the historic roots of United Methodism in the life, thought, and ministry of John Wesley (1703-1791), the founder of Methodism. Wesley can teach us much about who we are, from whence we have come, and what God calls us to do as we celebrate God's grace and witness for Jesus Christ. As we consider Wesley's ideas and his practice of Christian faith and mission, we hope to discover a vision for the renewal of our personal lives and the life of our church."

Through the use of quotes from John Wesley's sermons and other writings and the hymns of Charles Wesley, Charles Yrigoyen, Jr., presents the nature of the faith, the mission of the church, and the doctrine and theology of United Methodism.

The class will begin **September 17, 2006**. Bill Steele, our Lay Leader, will be leading the discussion. 
