The \$36,117 shortfall is through the first 8 months of 2013. We are currently experiencing over \$4,000 a month negative cash flow in the general fund.

Building Loan Repayment Fund

Donations: (Y.T.D.) \$ 9,733 Interest Expense: \$ 3,605 Principal Payments: \$12,011 Total Loan Expense: \$15,616 Shortfall: -\$ 5,883

The \$5,883 shortfall is through the first 8 months of 2013. We are currently experiencing \$735 per month shortfall.

Cash on Hand (8/31): \$3,308 Monthly mortgage: \$1,952 Loan Balance (8/31) \$75,700

The people of the eight United Methodist Churches in our area are coming together with the citizens of Wildomar and working to restore the three parks in Wildomar on Saturday, October 26, 2013.
