***RICK'S RAMBLINGS*****PASSIONATE WORSHIP**

Robert Schnase, United Methodist Bishop of the Missouri Conference, wrote a book entitled *Five Practices of Fruitful Congregations*. One of the five practices is passionate worship. Bishop Schnase writes, "Vibrant, fruitful, growing churches offer Passionate Worship that connects people to God and to one another." This is one of the leading areas of the Temecula United Methodist vision that was raised during our retreat in May of 2015. The Worship Team has explored how our worship can continue to develop by offering a place people can feel at home and be part of a family and in a growing relationship with God in Christ.

Bishop Schnase goes on to say, "People are searching for worship that is authentic alive, creative, and comprehensible, where they experience the life-changing presence of God in the presence of others." To bring this about for our church family, especially for those in our community who are searching for that connection, we have not only looked at how to bring alive our current worship, but also what alternative worship opportunities might reach different folks by changing style and approach. We have offered a spiritual contemplative worship from time to time. We have offered worship through music such as the *His Voice* concert. Over this year the Worship Team has thought how to reach the millennial generation that is missing in many of our churches. One cannot offer just one type of program to appeal to a whole generation, but one can offer a type that hits some of the particular characteristics of the generation.

The Worship Team formed a task force that has been looking at and planning a one-time worship experience that we hope will inspire and bring in a new segment of our community's people that is still searching for a church family. The team has come up with a theme for our worship experience called "F3": Faith, Food, Fun. Those who come to worship will learn and grow in their faith by experiencing and interacting within worship at times using social media, the web and smart phones to help make the message and

There is a new Worship Musical Team being formed that will lead us in contemporary praise music. This will be a time of fellowship and a meal with the first one being a barbeque. The premier of this new worship experience is set for **Saturday, August 6, at 5:00 PM.**

Although we are targeting a certain segment of the population in our community and in particular those looking for a different style of worship than we currently offer, success in helping new folks make this connection with our church family and with God will take the support and help of the whole family. Let me offer a few ways you can help.

1. Pray that God opens our doors so that those seeking a place of home and love through this worship experience feel the invitation.
2. Attend and participate. You may say, "This may not be my style. I like the service I attend now." By coming and attending you are letting the new persons and families know that attending is important and they are important to our family and to God.
3. Invite and bring someone you know in the millennial generation, perhaps a family you know that just might have fun with this style of worship experience. Remember you aren't asking them to come to an unlimited number of times. Just one time! If everyone brought two to four people, we would fill the Worship Center.
4. Help with welcoming, ushering, serving the food, and surround all who come with love and care.

Let me close with one more line from Bishop Schnase's book: "God in Christ, changes people's lives through passionate worship!" Let this be another way we can offer passionate worship.


