What's Next?

One of my favorite shows is *West Wing*. It is a show that revolves around the West Wing staff of a fictional White House Administration with President Jed Bartlett. Aaron Sorkin (producer, creator, writer) is noted for creating an up-tempo dialogue, conversation, walk and talk interaction among the characters. President Bartlett has a particular phrase he uses when he feels that the topic being talked about has been exhausted and it is time to move on. He will announce "What's next?"

Back in October of last year, after a number of small conversations, we gathered as a church family to discover what was next in our journey of becoming an open inclusive welcoming Church. As a congregation we voted to becoming a Reconciling Congregation. Some slight changes occurred, and other suggestions were raised. Then a Reconciling Task Force was created and had its first meeting at the end of January. The main emphasis for the gathering was to ask the question again, "what's next?" The group shared it was time to move on some of the previous suggestions and raise some other opportunities for us to becoming a more visible expression of being inclusive and welcoming of ALL in the community. This means not just to talk about being an all-inclusive, welcoming, reconciling congregation, but also to show it in our community by being one.

Several "what's next" tasks were raised and then presented to the Church Council for recognition and approval to move on. 1. A new banner/sign to replace the one at the corner of Margarita and Rancho Vista that would more clearly show we are Welcoming of All with rainbow colors as part of the design. 2. Display a rainbow flag visible to the community. 3. Revise and update a Welcome Statement to be placed on our website and other social media as well as our printed material. These actions were not done lightly without thought of others. To the contrary they were done with the thought and love of others in mind. This was to show this Church Family being followers of Christ by living out the commandments of loving our God with our whole being and in doing so loving our neighbor as ourselves.

Kathy Kasitz

It is such a joy to share a bit of the life of Kathy. She was born and raised in Alhambra, California. When she was 18, she and her parents moved to Vista. Kathy received her A.A. after attending Pasadena Community College and then Palomar Community College.

While at Palomar, a friend introduced her to Ray. Ray was involved with the Methodist youth group in Escondido, and so Kathy got involved too. Kathy's family had raised her in the Methodist Church, and she had regularly attended Sunday School, so it was a familiar place. In fact, she was wedding coordinator for over nine years at the church. Ray and Kathy were wed March 13, 1965. For three years, they started their married life in an apartment. While in the apartment, they had their son, Rick. Then Ray's parents urged them to build a home on a vacant corner lot next to their home in Escondido. For 21 years they lived next to Ray's parents.

Kathy felt it was time for another change, and they moved to an other area of Escondido, where they lived for nine years. But after difficulties with the HOA, with a neighbor cutting down her beloved trees and other problems, they moved to an area off of San Pasqual Valley Rd and Sunset. They had a half acre, which Kathy planted with over 50 trees of all kinds from fruit to ornamental. Everyone said their yard was like a lovely park. They had 700 square feet of artificial turf installed as their dog was allergic to grass! They soon had an over abundance of fruit. One year the Senior Gleaners picked 600 pounds of fruit and there was still a lot left over.

In addition to being a wedding coordinator for Escondido United Methodist Church, Kathy was also a secretary/office manager and bookkeeper. For 13 years she was office manager and bookkeeper for a drywall subcontractor. Then she worked in a real estate office in Rancho Santa Fe. She also got her real estate license. She worked five more years as office manager in a construction company. She and Ray retired at the age of 62 and spent time developing their backyard garden.

Ray's declining health led them to decide to move to Temecula in 2015. Also, their son and family wanted to move to Temecula. They had one granddaughter, Sydney, and Kathy was blessed to babysit her three days a week until she entered school. Sidney is now 8 1/2.

Kathy loves animals, especially Boston Terriers. She has had nine of them! She also loves to piece quilt tops and has participated in Prayers and Squares. And, she loves gardening, going out to dinner, and funny and light-hearted movies. Kathy is one of our money counters. And, she is our attendance clerk, taking the information out of the red folders, recording it and then letting Pastor Rick and the Welcoming and Outreach Team know about new people who have signed in.

Kathy said that her spiritual journey is an on-going thing. For the past two or so years she has participated in the Tuesday Ladies study group. In this group and other studies, she feels she has learned much. Her spiritual life grows more and more important as the years pass. Being here, part of this church, has accelerated her growth.
